



- “savethedonkeyfield.co.uk” has now been established as an Unincorporated Organisation and registered with the ICO, recognising the need for compliance with GDPR.

- **The Oak Tree** - We continue to pursue clarity from the Forestry Commission regarding the legality of Eton College’s agents felling the 150-yrs old oak.
- Eton College have confirmed that the tree was removed to provide access to the Field (from Solent View Road).
- There is however no right of vehicular access from Solent View Road.
- **The SHLAA Process**
- A Freedom of Information request to the IW Council regarding the content of any pre-application advice given to Eton College’s then agents. We have now received relevant documentation relating to such advice given in December 2019.
- We have ascertained from that advice that the Local Planning Authority recognised the importance of the green corridor of the Donkey Field lying between Seaview and Nettlestone, problems of access and the presence of valued trees, one of which is no longer extant!
- **There is no Planning Application yet**
- We are working to be prepared for such an eventuality.
