



**Felling of the Oak Tree.**

- Our correspondence with the Forestry Commission has continued.
- Next step by the Forestry Commission should be a report to their National Office who will then decide whether or not to refer the matter to the Crown Prosecution Service.
- Eton's Bursar claims the volume of felled trees was less than 5Cu Mt so no felling licence was required. We have instructed our own expert to calculate the volume.

**Access from Solent View Road and/or via Seagrove Farm Road**

- FOI requests have disclosed pre-planning applications to the IW Council in respect of the Farmers Field (2015, 2016 and 2018) and the Donkey Field (2019). We are seeking further disclosure.
- Highway access was intended to be created from both roads.
- Our view is that neither route is acceptable nor available for differing reasons.
- The Company that bought 51 Solent View Road is controlled by the same person who made the pre-planning application in 2018.

**The SHLAA Process**

- We continue to seek a revision of the SHLAA determination on the Donkey Field as we contend it was based on inaccurate information.
